

Arts Health Research Intensive 2025: Accommodation

The course fee does not cover travel or accommodation, which delegates should make their own arrangements for. This is an overview of some of the accommodation options available for your stay during the Arts Health Research Intensive (19 – 23 May 2025), which will take place at Britten Pears Arts in Snape Maltings, Suffolk, UK.

Elizabeth Court

We have reserved a limited number of rooms at Elizabeth Court in the local coastal town of Aldeburgh, located 6 miles from Snape Maltings. Previously delegates staying here coordinated car/taxi sharing between the accommodation and course site. This is the only accommodation option being coordinated by the Social Biobehavioural Research Group. A link to book a room, alongside further information, will be provided once you have booked your place on the course.

There are 16 rooms available at Elizabeth Court. They are bookable for 5 (Sun – Fri) or 6 (Sun – Sat) nights and are being offered at the following price points:

- Private twin room, single occupancy (£60 per person per night inc VAT)
- Shared twin room, shared with 1 other person (£42 per person per night inc VAT)
- Private double en-suite room, single occupancy (£72 per person per night inc VAT)
- Shared double en-suite room, shared with 1 other person (£48 per person per night inc VAT)

There is a limited number of en-suite rooms. Twin rooms have access to shared bathroom facilities. This accommodation is self-catered and located close to local shops, cafés and a cinema. More information about Elizabeth Court is available [here](#).
